- 3. Announce that the recollection is at 7:30 am - 5:00 pm at Balay Kalinungan. Please come on time, late comers will not be allowed to join their class. Students who were late or absent will have to go to the CELAM office immediately.
- 4. Assign the class officers to organize purchase of the offertory items for the mass. This will be donated to Bahay Pag-asa and the staff particularly requests the following items: Bath soap, laundry soap, shampoo, toothpaste, rexonax for men (in sachet) and biscuits (in individual packs).
- 5. Remind the students to bring ball pens.
- 6. Please instruct students to follow dress code. Strictly no shorts for men and women, no slippers, no miniskirts / sleeveless / backless / revealing clothes.

The student recollections are part of their Lasallian formation; therefore, attendance in the recollection is an INSTITUTIONAL REQUIREMENT. It is also part of the requirements for the students' clearance at the end of the semester.
