AUTOMATIC SUSPENSION GUIDELINES

SIGNAL #1 No classes in Kindergarten

SIGNAL #2 No classes in Kindergarten, Elementary, and High School

SIGNAL #3 or HIGHER No classes in Kindergarten, Elementary, High School, and College (including Graduate School)

REMINDER: The local government unit (LGU) has the authority to declare local suspensions in areas where there is no storm signal.

Check Executive Order No. 66, s. 2012 for complete rules on cancellation or suspension of classes.

In line with the DEPED guidelines and as previously approved by the Operations Council, related faculty and staff specifically assigned to the automatically suspended units shall not be required to report to office on the same day. For Signal#3, all Administrative offices shall likewise be suspended.

LGU and/or Official PAG-ASA announcements over Negros Occidental shall be the basis for the implementation of the same with confirmation through the USLS website, through email and/or SMS from the Unit Heads. Suspension of office for succeeding days shall be specifically announced through the same medium.
