- Special Exams will only be granted to students who missed the scheduled exams due to serious reasons like illness, accident and other unavoidable circumstances (SHB p. 53). **Parents/students need to submit a letter of excuse** (with medical certificate, if applicable) to the LVP/DFO Office to be forwarded to the VPA Office for approval.
- SOP on absences should be followed by the student upon returning to school.
- Students are required to pay P30.00 for every exam missed to defray special exam preparation. Exception: Those who attended school-sanctioned activities.
- Students who missed the exams due to school-sanctioned activities are granted Special Exams Permit.**
- Approved** Special Exams will be given on the said dates, following the same 3-day schedule. However, students may only take special exams **during the 7th-8th periods** so that they can attend to their Performance Tasks in class at least in the morning until the 6th period.
