1. Special Exams will only be granted to students who missed the scheduled exams due to serious reasons like illness, accident and other unavoidable circumstances (SHB p. 53). **Parents/students need to submit a letter of excuse** (with medical certificate, if applicable) to the LVP/DFO Office to be forwarded to the VPA Office for approval.
2. SOP on absences should be followed by the student upon returning to school.
3. Students are required to pay P30.00 for every exam missed to defray special exam preparation. Exception: Those who attended school-sanctioned activities.
4. **Students who missed the exams due to school-sanctioned activities are granted Special Exams Permit.**
5. **Approved** Special Exams will be given on the said dates, following the same 3-day schedule. However, students may only take special exams **during the 7th-8th periods** so that they can attend to their Performance Tasks in class at least in the morning until the 6th period.
6. Special Exam Proctors will be assigned to take charge of administering the assessments in respective venues:

Upper Grades – **Tech Room** / RDJ Library
