

SEAT PLAN



FROM LASBEMPCO**ELECTION 2020 GUIDELINES****I. VACANT POSITIONS FOR ELECTION**

Board of Directors - **FOUR (4)** (Admin/College/B & G)
ONE (1) (USLS-IS)

II. QUALIFICATIONS

1. Bona fide LASBEMPCO member with at least one-year length of membership.
2. Of good standing and moral values
3. NO delinquent account for more than 3 months
4. For BOD seeking for re-election are subject to By-Laws.

III. FILING OF COC's

1. Certificate of Candidacy must be duly accomplished in two (2) copies and certified (as provided thereto).
2. Must be filed personally to any members of the ELECOM.
3. Within 48 hours after deadline, the ELECOM shall post the official candidates.
4. The ELECOM reserves the right to disqualify a candidate based on the qualifications above provided and/or due to acts in violations of the **Election Guidelines**.
5. Get COC's at LICEO Discipline's Office (**c/o Mr. Gilrey Vocales**), College Discipline's Office (**c/o Mr. Michael Lobaton or Mr. Alvie Briones**), HRDS Office (**c/o Mr. Marion Opu-an**) and Varsity Sports Office (**c/o Mr. Harley Hojilla**)

IV. PROTESTS

1. Prequalification protest against a candidate must be filed to the ELECOM not later than 24 hours after posting the official candidates. NO prequalification protest shall be entertained after the period provided.
2. Prequalification protest/s shall be resolved by the ELECOM within 48 hours from receipt of the written protest.
3. Election protest on irregularities, conduct of election and counting must be filed in writing before the proclamation of winners.
4. No election protest shall be entertained after the proclamation of winners by the ELECOM.
5. Election protest/s shall be resolved within 72 hours from receipt of the written protest.
