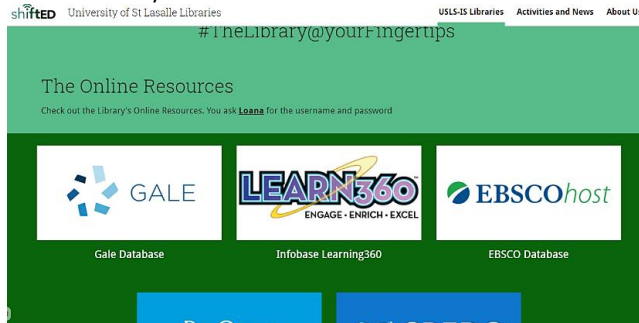

WORLD WAR II MONEY IN NEGROS

Personal And Financial Management Concerns

I was authorized by Gen. MacArthur to use the script or emergency money in the mountain areas. We had a printing press for printing script money. For the bigger denominations, I and the treasurer (provincial) would sign all the script money we issued. The printing machine was kept in the mountains in Murcia just near our house. We counted all the papers. Some script money are now in the museum of the Central Bank. The printing machine was not so good. It did not have a letter press. There was nothing to be used for the cleaning or replacement of some of its parts. But we could not stop the printing of the script money because we had to use this for payment of salaries of the civil government employees and also for procurement. I didn't know where we got the printing machine. If we needed something, I told my treasurer and my treasurer would consult with the army and the army would be responsible for looking for the things we needed. If they knew of the source of things we needed, the army tried to secure them immediately. They always consulted the owners and the owners always gave their consent to the idea. We could not take anything without the owner's consent, otherwise we will be reported to the Japanese.

About 30 million pesos worth of script money was printed. These currencies were redeemed after the war. Even then, hundreds of thousands of pesos deposited including my own money were not redeemed. I said I will just contribute that to the war.
