Major in National Security and Law Enforcement

Program Description

The Master in Public Management (MPM) program, with specialization in National Security and Law Enforcement, is a specially-designed comprehensive program that integrates concepts of public administration and governance with fundamental concepts and issues on national security and law enforcement.

These two curriculum components are organized around functional and multi-disciplinary contexts designed to broaden the knowledge, skills and attitude of officials of the Philippine National Police to enable them to effectively perform their various responsibilities and meet the challenges emanating from the internal and external environment.

Program Educational Objectives

In line with University Mission Statement, the program is designed to:

1. strengthen the conceptual orientation and knowledge of program participants;
2. develop their professional and administrative skills; and
3. promote an ethical and social value system in their personal and professional lives.

Admission Policies

A student seeking admission to the program must comply with the following:

1. hold a bachelor's degree from an accredited college or university;
2. must be serving the Philippine National Police;
3. have to take the entrance tests of aptitude and critical thinking;
4. have to pass the panel interview; and
5. have to submit other required documents for admission.

Retention Policies

To be retained in the program, the student must:

1. maintain a satisfactory cumulative Grade Point Average (GPA) of 1.75 (90) or better in all subjects taken for the entire duration of the program; and
2. have not incurred a failure in any subject.
