Major in MARRIAGE AND FAMILY

Program Description

This program aims to give the students the opportunity to deepen their awareness of marriage and family in the light of faith. This program uses the interdisciplinary approach to prepare the students in their exercise of more qualified services towards marriage and family life ministry in their own communities.

Program Educational Objectives

Specifically, the program aims to:

1. develop strong family structures whose core values are anchored on Catholic Teachings on marriage, family and life; and
2. evangelize and transform society through faith witnessing of positive Catholic families.

Admission Policies

A student seeking admission to the program must comply with the following:

1. hold a degree with at least 12 units professional courses in education or other related fields from an accredited college or university; and
2. have to take the entrance tests of aptitude (CEM - Graduate Level Test on Verbal, Quantitative and Inductive Reasoning) and essay that will measure written communication skill;
3. have to pass the panel interview; and
4. have to submit other required documents for admission.

Retention Policies

To be retained in the program, the student must:

1. maintain a satisfactory cumulative Grade Point Average (GPA) of 2.0 (85) or better in all subjects taken for the entire duration of the program; and
2. have not incurred a failure in any subject.
