### **Program Description**

### **Admission Policies**

A student seeking admission to the program must comply with the following:

1. hold a degree in Mathematics with 12 units professional courses in education or other related fields from accredited college or university;
  - 1.1 An applicant with insufficient background in mathematics will be required to take prerequisite courses up 12 units.
2. have to take the entrance tests of aptitude (CEM-Graduate Level Test on Verbal Quantitative and Inductive Reasoning) and essay that will measure written communication skill;
3. have to pass the panel interview; and
4. have to submit other required documents for admission.
