Program Description

This is a non-thesis program designed for those who are committed to teaching English, Reading, and Literature. The courses are directed toward practical pedagogical applications of theoretical principles derived from the fields of linguistics, literature, and reading. Students are trained in the teaching of reading and writing, speaking, and listening in English, as well as in the appreciation of literature. Additional emphasis is given to curriculum design and management.

1. Exhibit deeper understanding of the nature, operations and functions of communication;
2. Acquire the necessary Pedagogical application of theories/principles in teaching linguistics; literature; reading and writing; speaking and listening in English;
3. Enhance and expand technical knowledge for teaching a specific area in communication for global competitiveness; and
4. Develop research capabilities for applying practical knowledge relative to the disciplines.
