

MASTER IN EDUCATION (MEd)

Major in Special Education

Program Description

The Master in Special Education (MSE) aims to provide the knowledge and skills needed for teaching and working with differently-abled children in the family and in settings like preschool, daycare centers, orphanages and others. The program emphasizes the theoretical applications not only in instruction but also the development of school and individual programs.

Program Educational Objectives

Specifically, the program aims to:

1. provide training and enrichment;
2. develop social responsibility in their role as educators and practitioners for nation building
3. enhance research capabilities in the context of Filipino culture.

Admission Policies

A student seeking admission to the program must comply with the following:

1. hold a degree in Special Education with at least 12 units of professional course in education or other related fields from an accredited college or university;
2. have to take the entrance tests of aptitude (CEM- Graduate Level Test on Verbal, Quantitative and Inductive Reasoning) and essay that will measure written communication skill;
3. have to pass the panel interview; and
4. have to submit other required documents for admission.

Retention Policies

To be retained in the program, the student must:

1. maintain a satisfactory cumulative Grade Point Average (GPA) of 2.0 (85) or better in all subjects taken for the entire duration of the program; and
2. have not incurred a failure in any subject.
