To prevent unauthorized persons, weapons, dangerous objects, & other security risks from entering areas where our students study, work, & participate in activities.

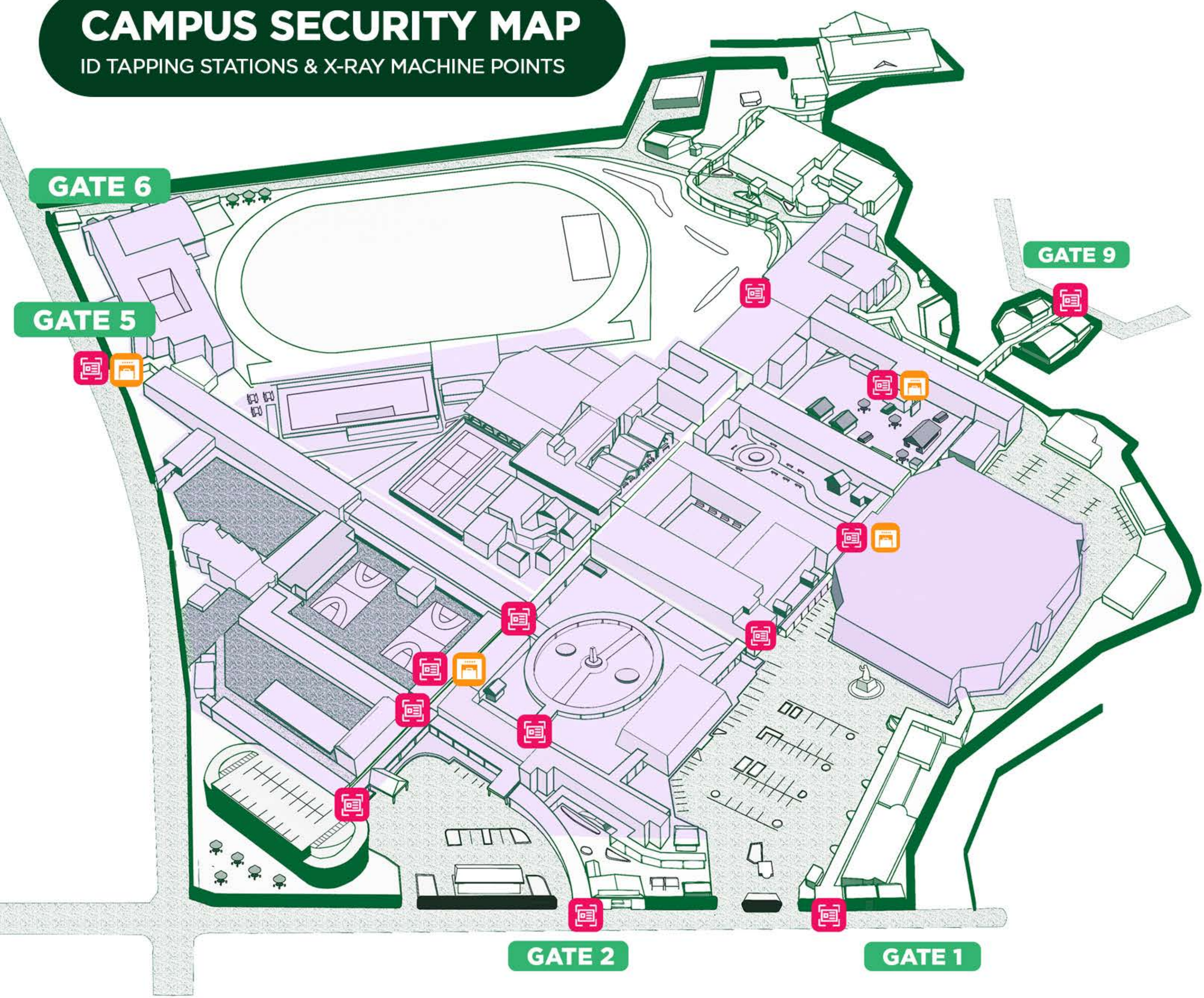
OUR GOAL

RESTRICTED AREAS

- Only authorized persons with valid ID may enter restricted areas:
- Students, faculty, and staff with valid USLS IDs
 - Agency/concessionaire personnel with recognized IDs
 - Visitors with confirmed appointments or official business
 - Others specifically authorized by the University

4-STEP SECURITY SCREENING PROCESS

1 ID VERIFICATION



Verify your identity by tapping your official USLS ID at designated stations

2 METAL DETECTOR SCREENING



Pass through the walk-through metal detector

3 X-RAY OR BAGGAGE SCREENING



Place your bags & belongings on the X-ray scanner

4 ENTRY INTO THE RESTRICTED AREA



Proceed only after completing all screening steps



All persons must first establish that they are authorized to enter university premises



Reasonable and appropriate accommodations for persons with disabilities, children, and individuals with special needs

WHO MAY ENTER THE RESTRICTED AREAS

-  Students, Faculty, and Staff with valid USLS IDs.
-  Authorized agency personnel with USLS-issued or recognized IDs.
-  Concessionaire personnel with USLS-issued or recognized IDs.
-  Visitors and guests with confirmed appointments or legitimate official business who have registered and obtained a Visitor's ID.
-  Other persons specifically authorized by the University.



Parents, guardians, fetchers, and other persons without legitimate official business and confirmed appointments shall not be allowed beyond the Security Checkpoints.

STUDENTS WITHOUT IDs



A student without his or her official USLS ID shall not be allowed to enter any Restricted Area.



Proceed to Gate 2 and request a Temporary Pass.



Only upon issuance of the Temporary Pass may the student proceed to the Security Checkpoint and undergo the required screening.



BODY-WORN CAMERAS

All security personnel assigned in the campus are required to wear and use body-worn cameras in the performance of their duties.



These cameras promote transparency, accountability, and safer interactions while adhering to data privacy policies.

WHAT WE SCREEN FOR

Weapons, dangerous objects, and other prohibited items.
